

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING: CITY OF NOVATO
Council Meeting
Bahia Mini Parks Improvements CIP 15-004

The City of Novato City Council is scheduled to consider approving the Bahia Mini Parks improvements final design at their **Tuesday May 17, 2016** meeting at 6:30 pm at Novato City Hall, 901 Sherman Avenue. The design was developed with the Bahia Parks Committee and shared with the public at a workshop before being recommended for approval by the Recreation, Cultural and Community Services Advisory Commission. The proposed improvements include a play structure, swings, pergola/shade structure, picnic tables and benches at the largest park across from Andale Avenue (Park C), and amenities including a pergola, picnic table and benches at the second largest park across from Malobar Drive (Park B).

The project proposes removing four trees at Park C (including two large Pine trees). These trees were planted 40-plus years ago with the original park improvements, and due to their poor condition (stressed, poor growth and dead branches), are not considered appropriate trees for the improved parks. Eight new replacement trees are proposed at Park C as part of this project.

It is anticipated that construction will begin in August of this year, and that the improvements will be complete by the end of October, 2016.

This meeting is open to the public, and anyone wishing to offer comments or ask questions about this project is invited to do so during the public comments session at the beginning of the meeting, as this item is scheduled for the consent calendar, meaning there will be no formal presentation of the item, unless the item is removed for discussion by a Councilmember.
