



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is decommissioning the water treatment plant and preparing the North Antenna Field for its upcoming environmental cleanup.

These activities will increase truck traffic along Todd's Road.

North Antenna Field

From the end of February, trucks will start to deliver equipment intermittently to the North Antenna Field. Additionally a small number of personnel vehicles will use Todd's Road on route to the project site.

Water Treatment Plant

During the first three weeks of March, two trucks twice a week will be used for the decommissioning of the water treatment plant.

Working hours: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, maintenance vehicle will arrive at 7:00 am.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is committed to minimizing disruptions to residents. All project vehicles, including privately owned pickup trucks will be identifiable by the FUDS project sign above.
